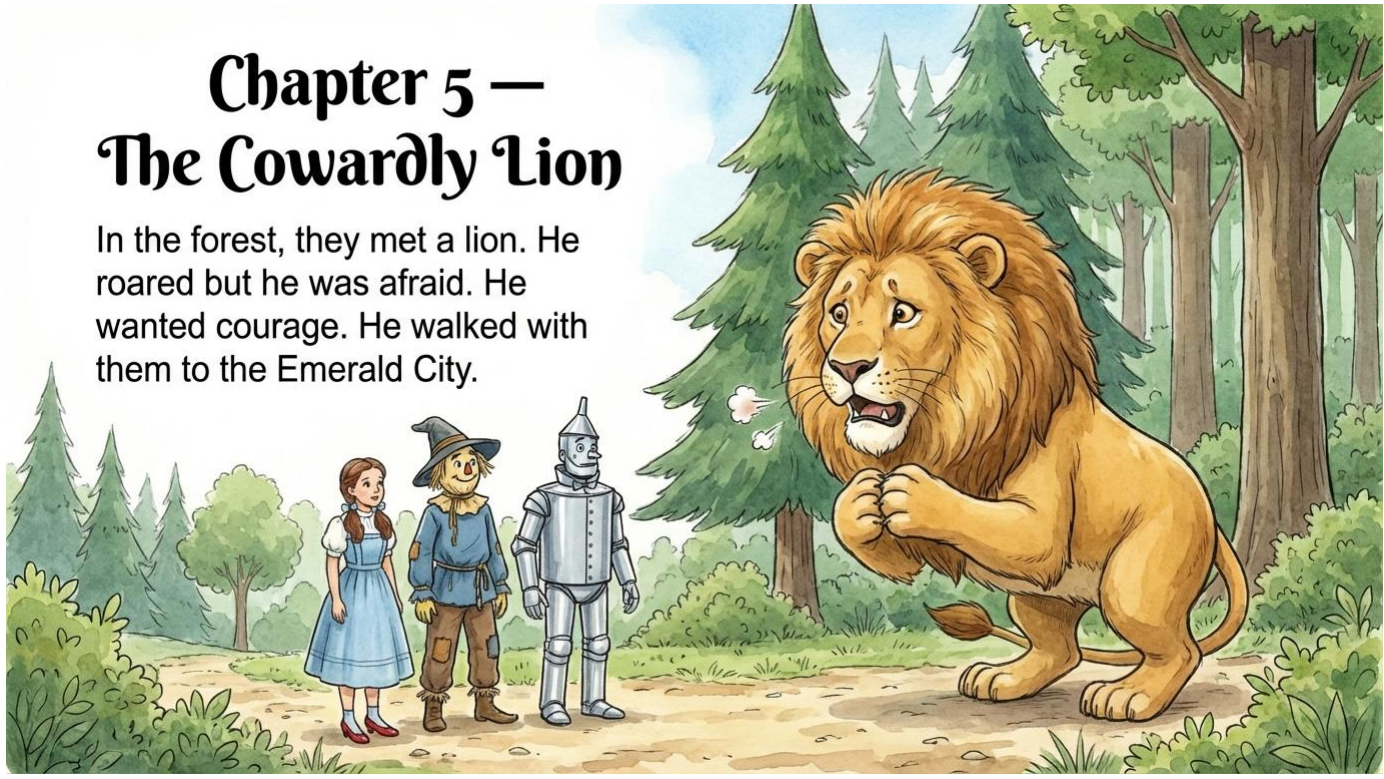
Chapter 4 — The Road Through the Forest

Then he would help Dorothy go home.



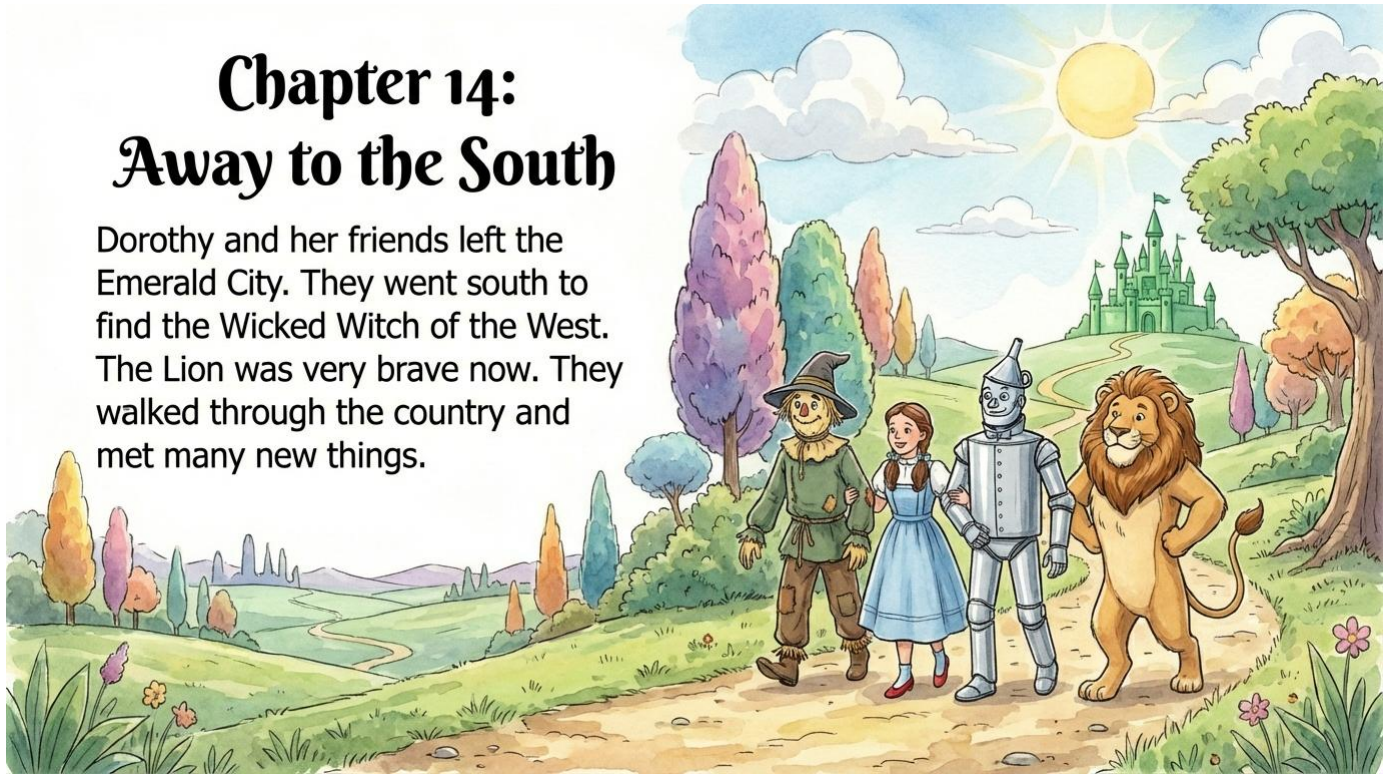
Chapter 13 — How the Balloon Was Launched

The road led into a forest of Fighting Trees. The trees hit them with their branches. Dorothy and her friends ran and found a way out. They kept going south.



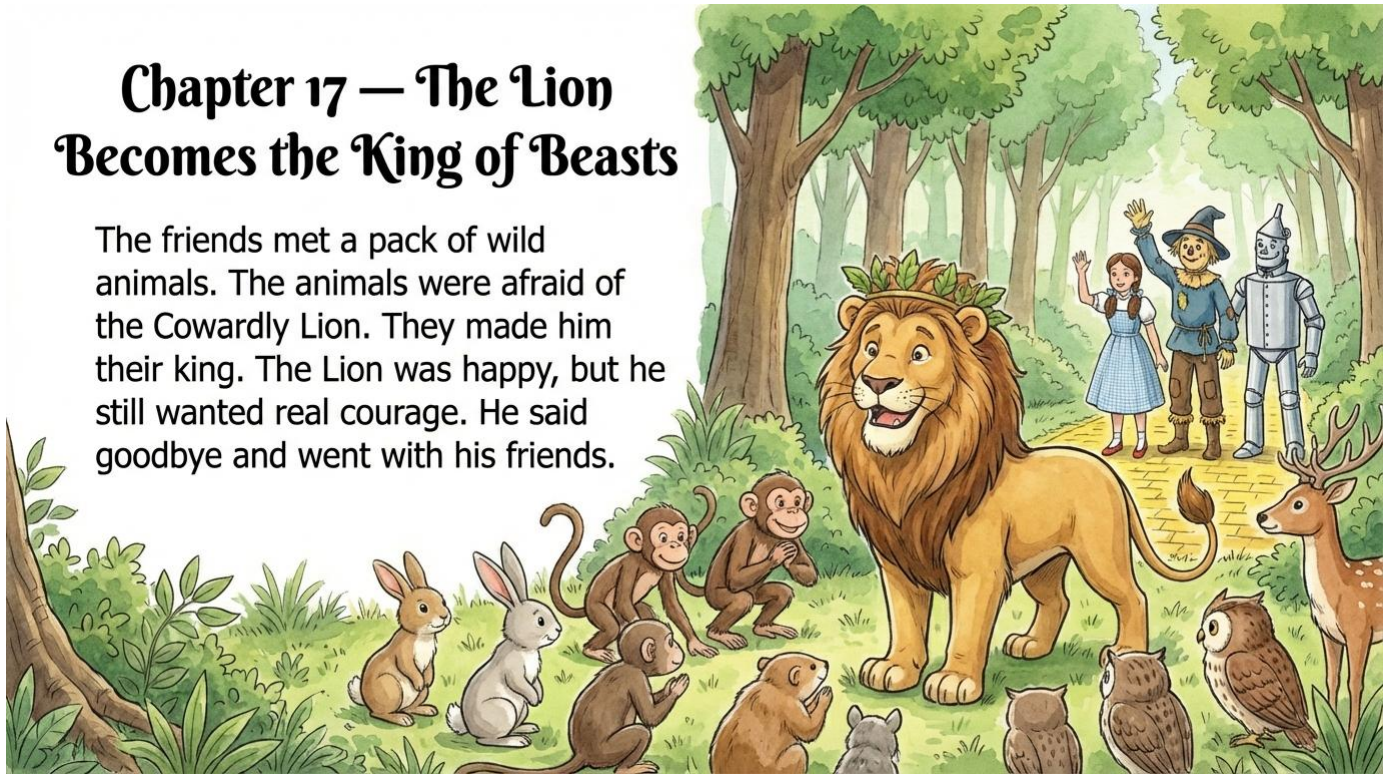
Chapter 16 – The Dainty China Country

Chapter 17 — The Lion Becomes the King of Beasts

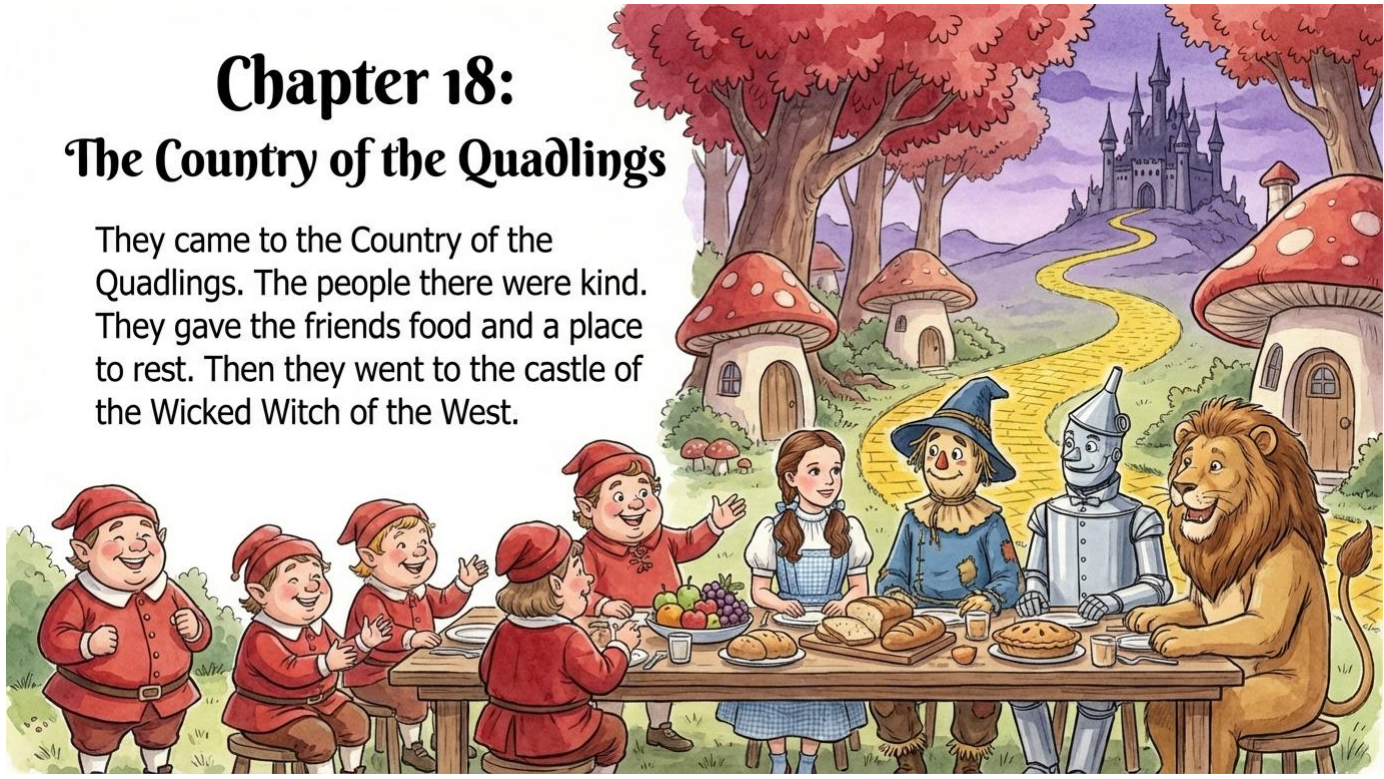
