

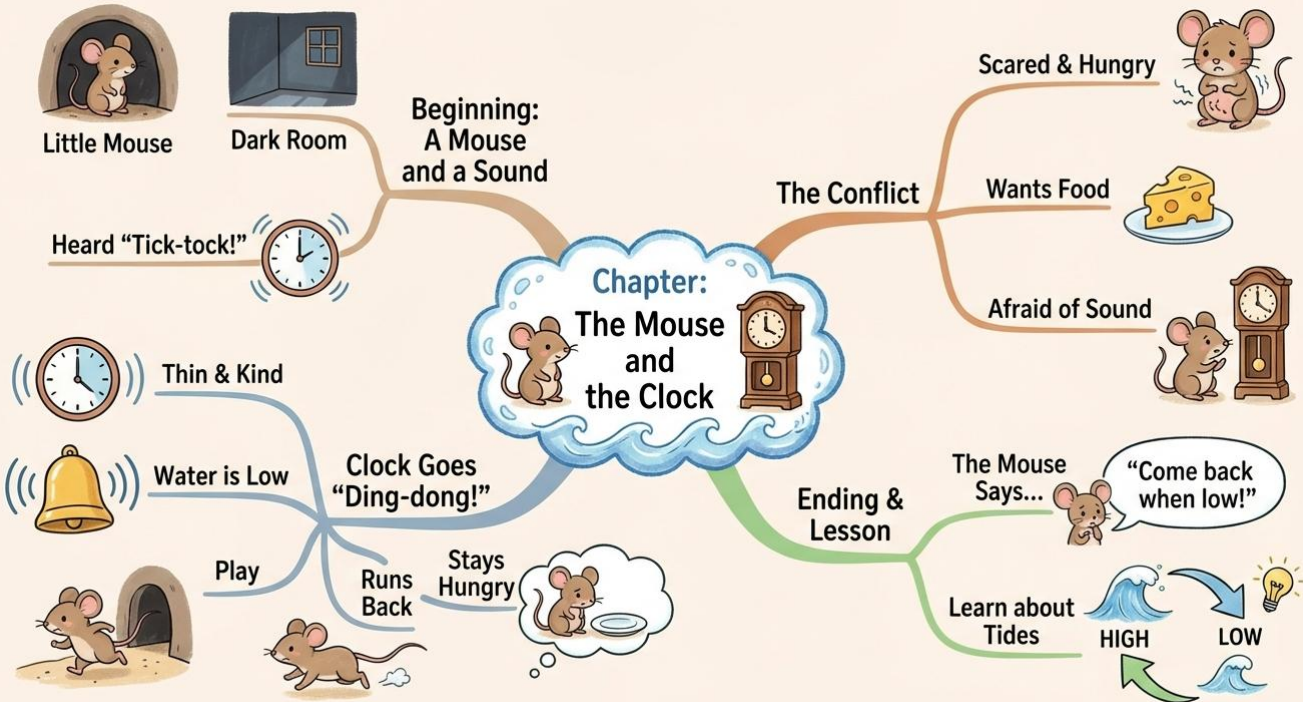
## Chapter: The Mouse and the Clock

But he is afraid of the sound.

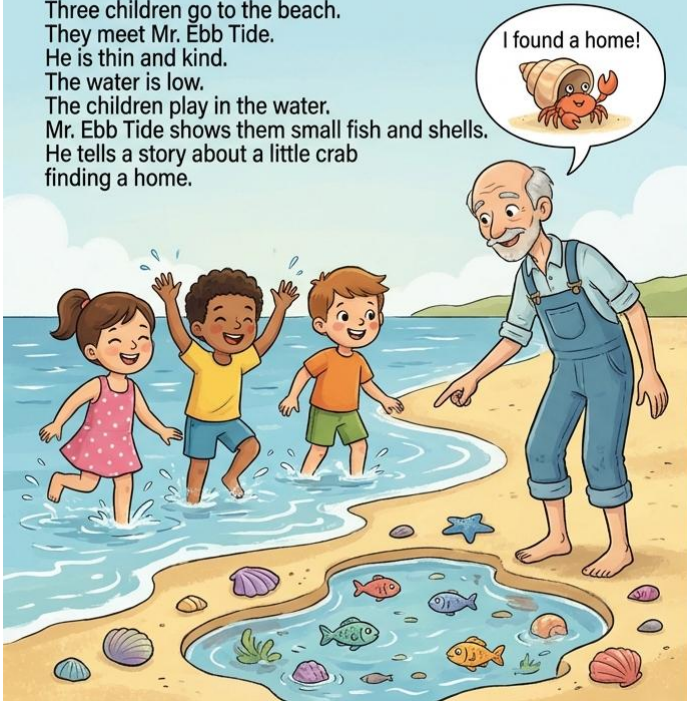


The mouse tries to go out.

He stays hungry all night.



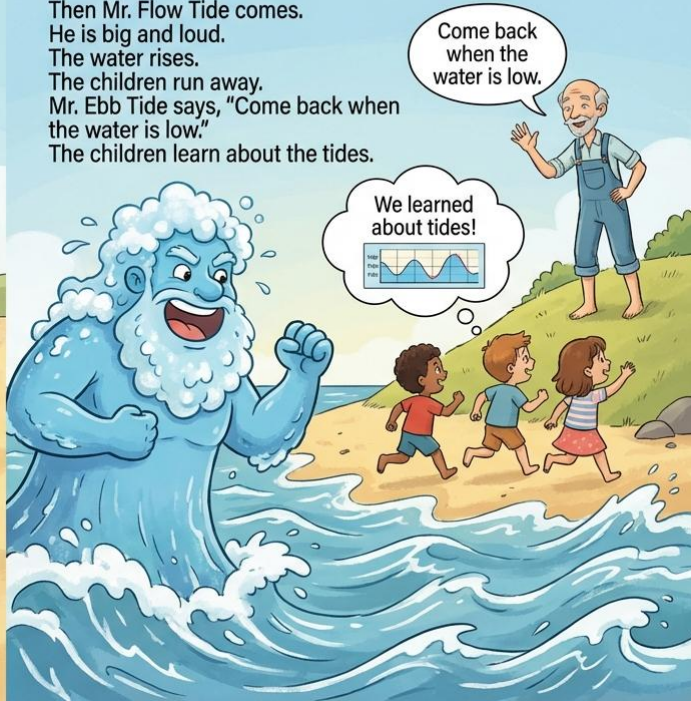
## Chapter: Mr. Ebb Tide and Mr. Flow Tide

finding a home.

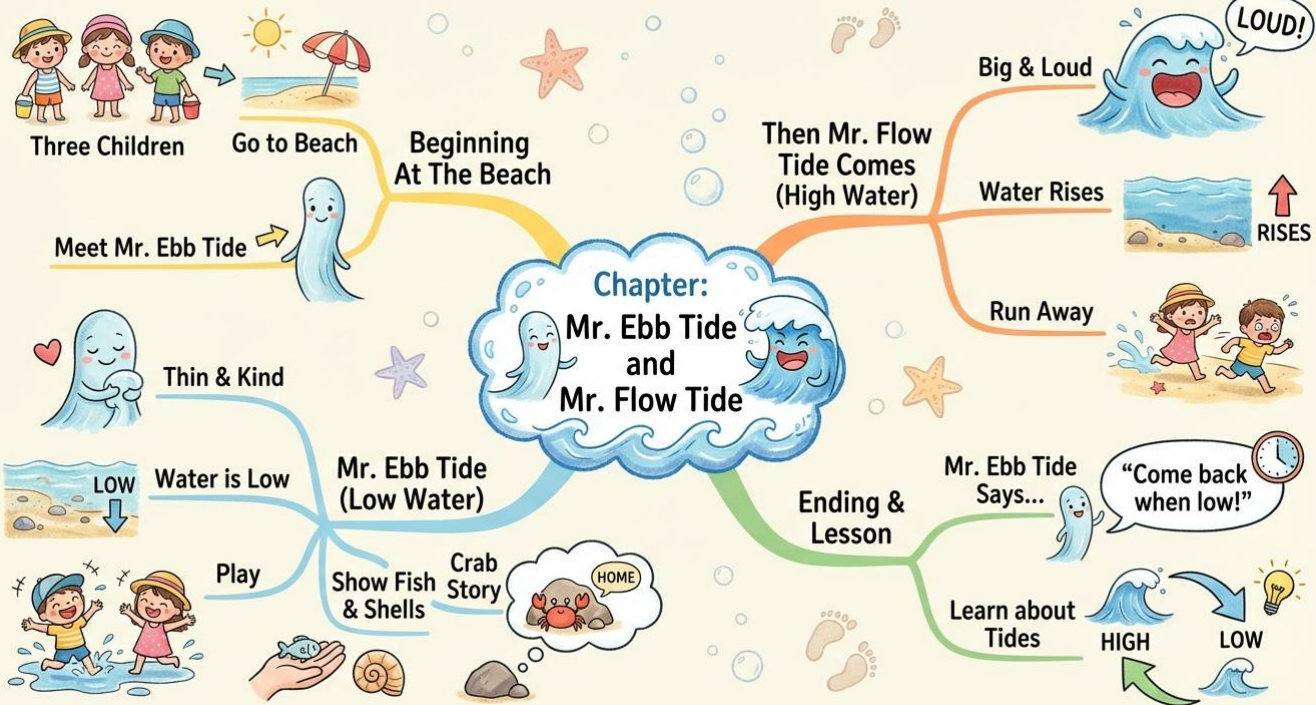


## Chapter: Mr. Ebb Tide and Mr. Flow Tide

The children learn about the tides.





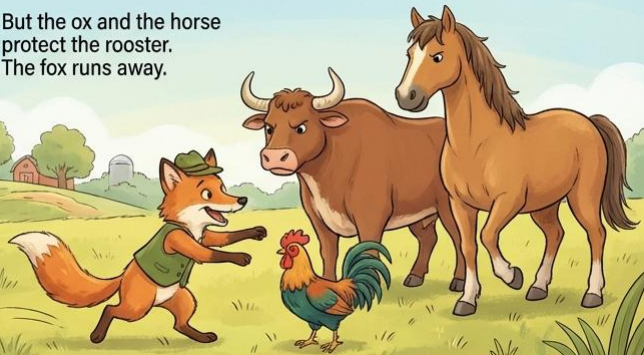


## Chapter: What the Three Little Magpies Said

The fox runs away.



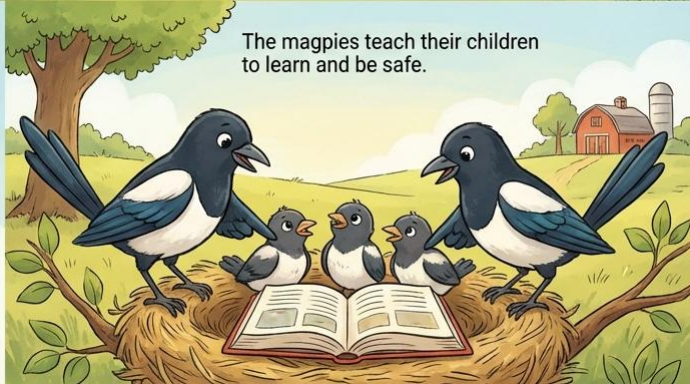
The fox
