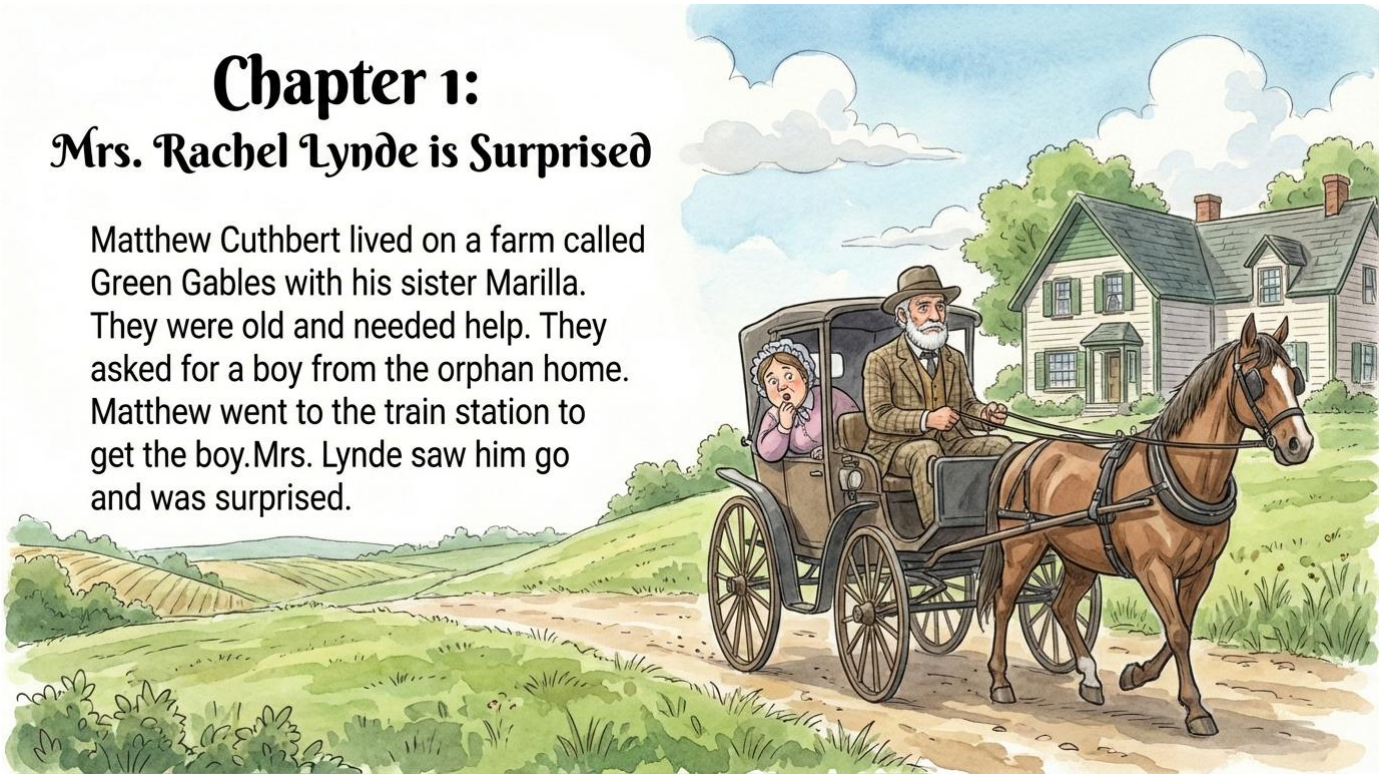


Chapter 1:

Chapter 5: Anne's History

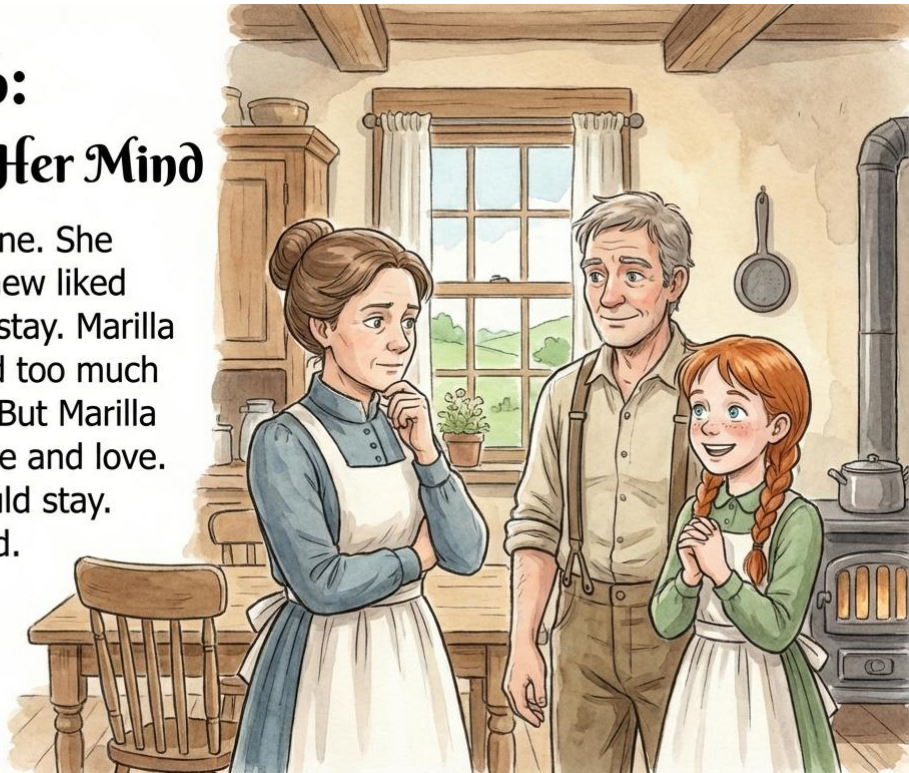

Marilla Makes Up Her Mind

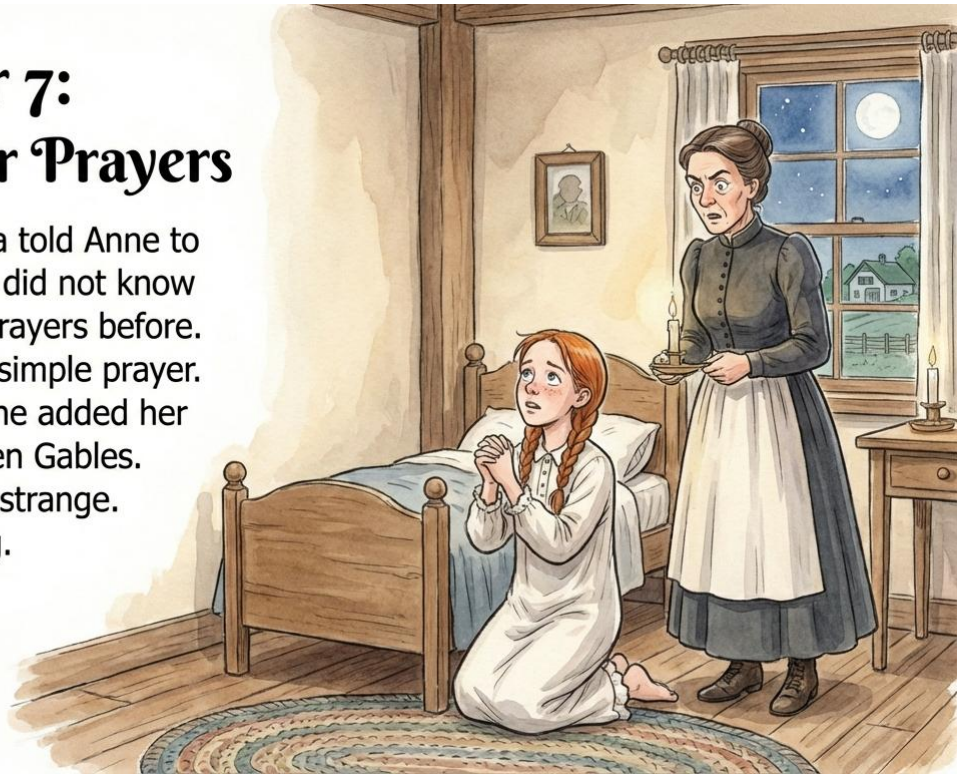

Chapter 7:

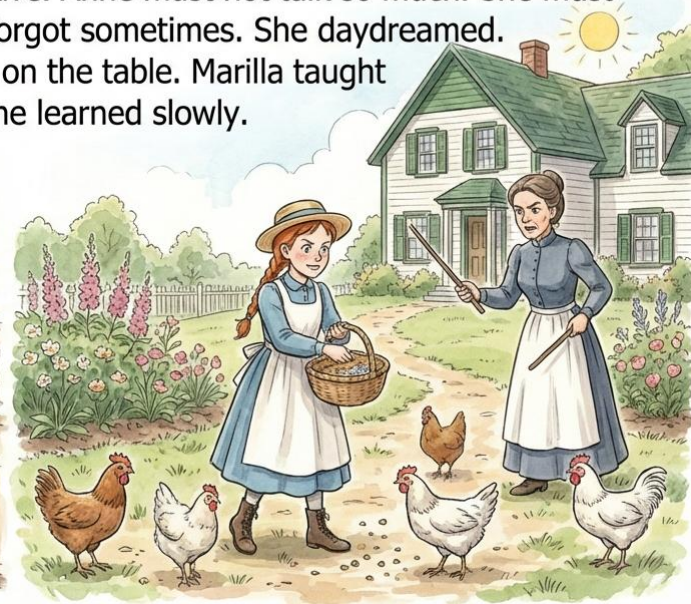
Anne Says Her Prayers

Mrs. Rachel Lynde is Horrified

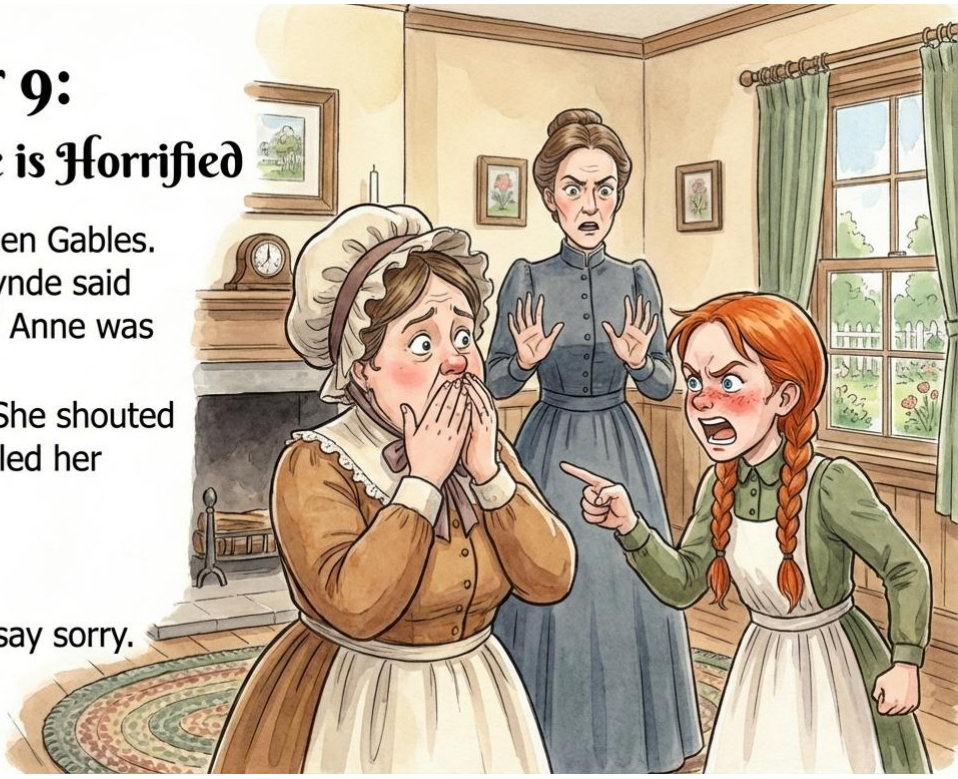
Mrs. Lynde visited Green Gables. She saw Anne. Mrs. Lynde said mean things. She said Anne was ugly and had red hair.

Anne's Sunday School Debut

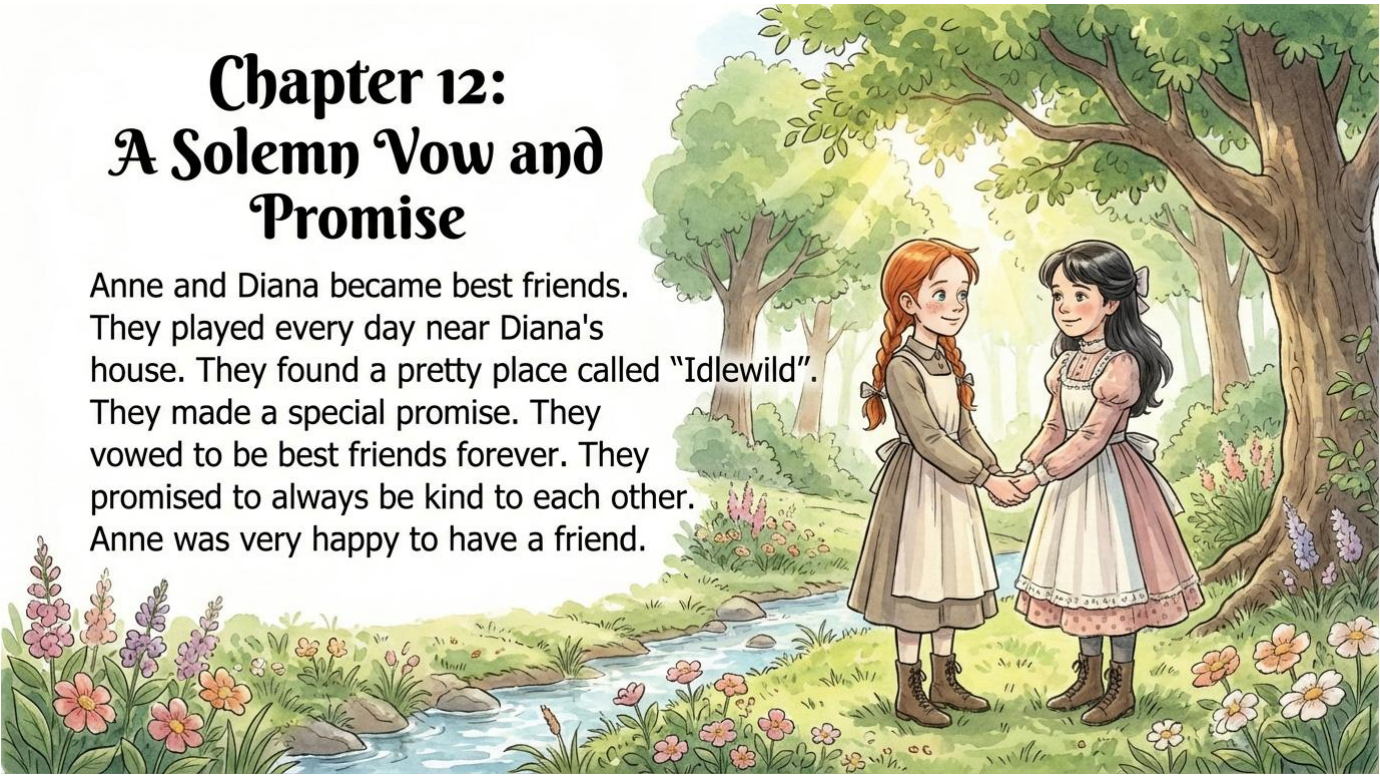
Anne went to church on Sunday.

Anne Learns a Lesson

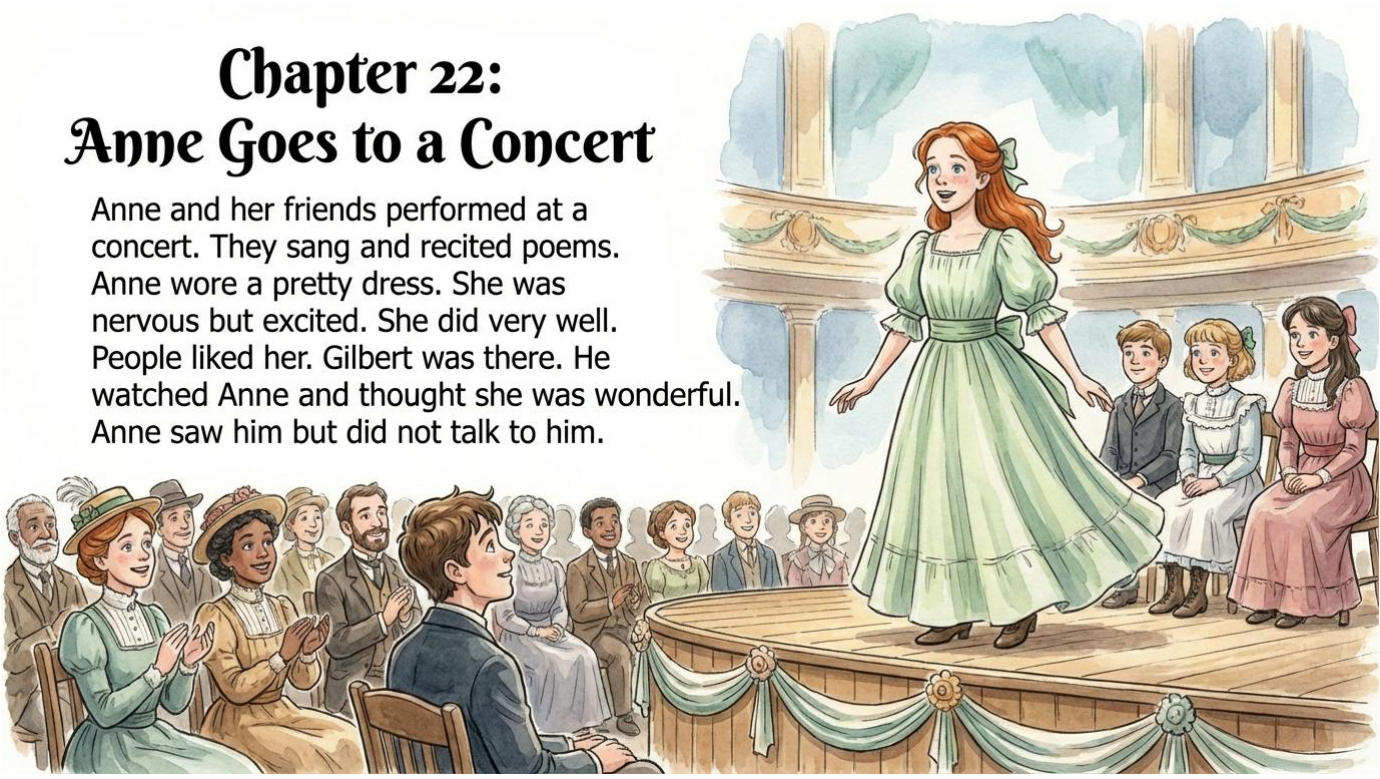

Anne Goes to a Concert

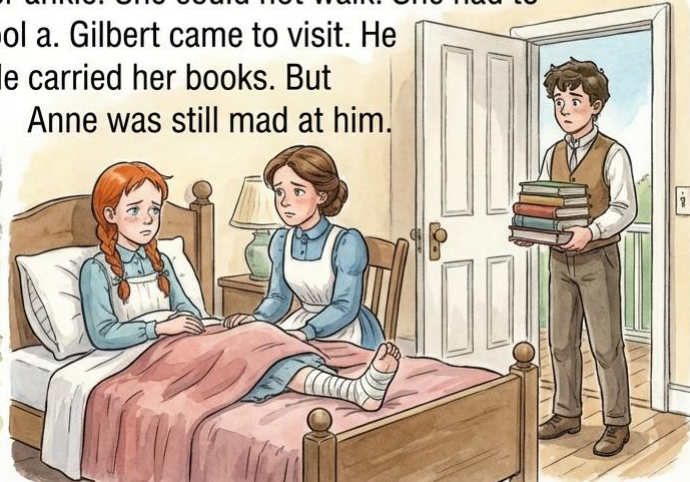

Chapter 24: Matthew Insists on Puffed Sleeves

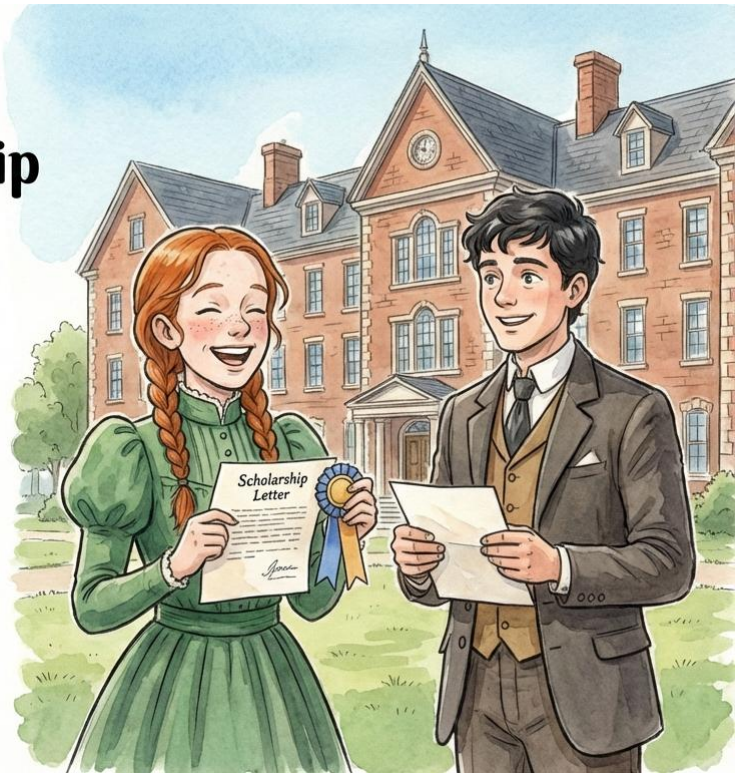

Chapter 25:

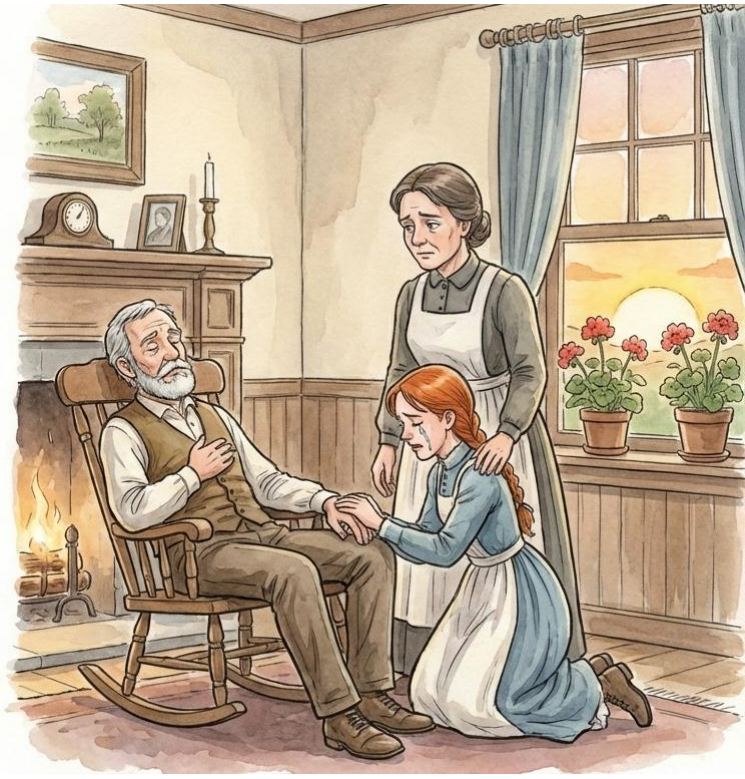
Anne Wins a Scholarship

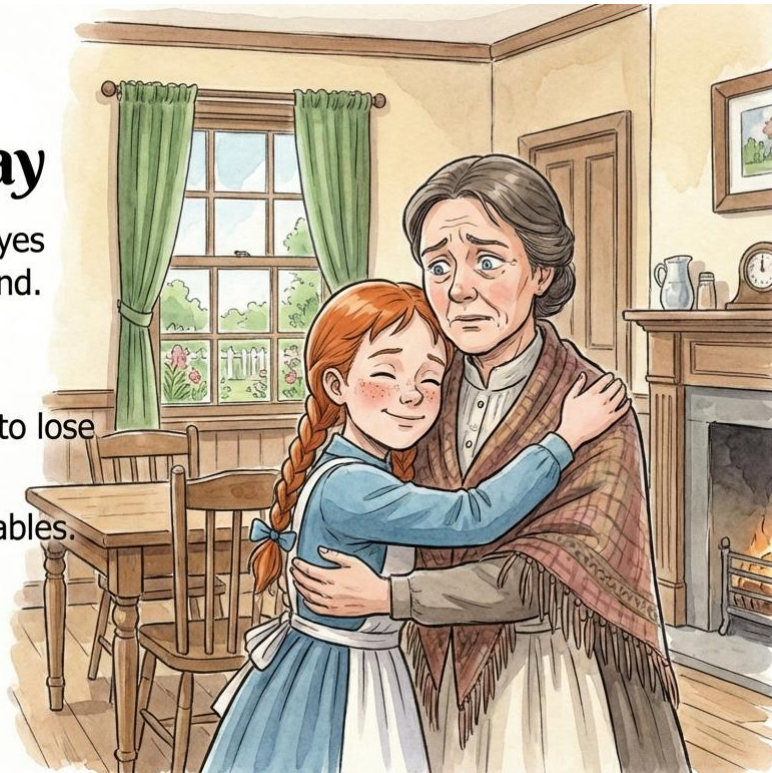
Chapter 27:
