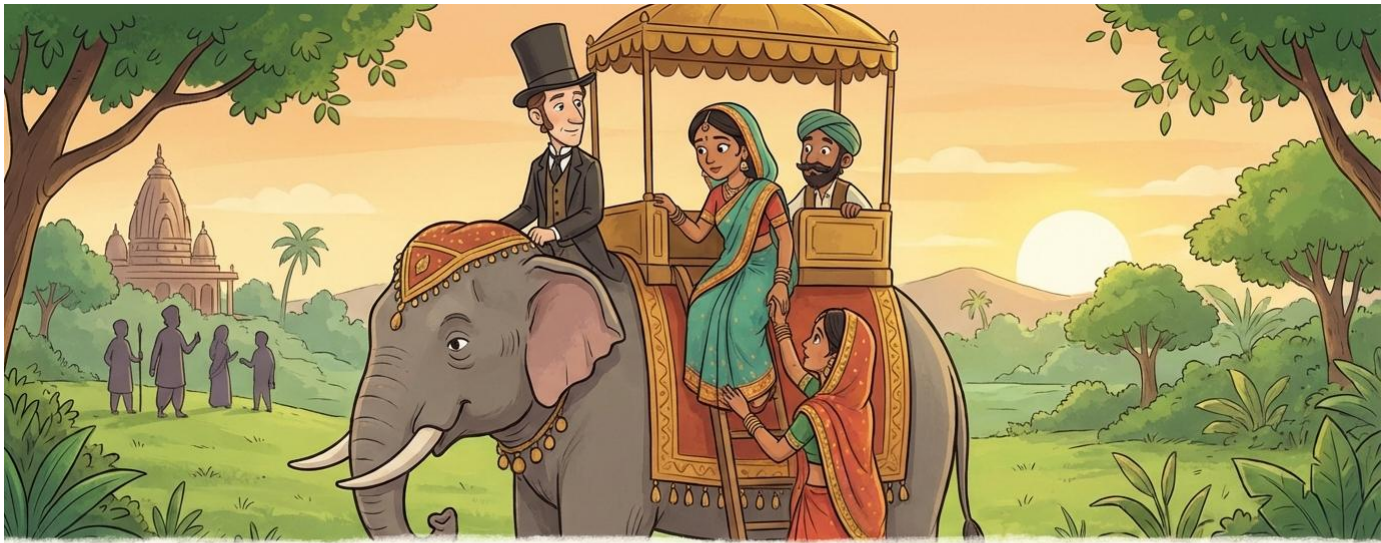
Chapter 5: On the Way to India

Chapter 15: A Happy Reunion

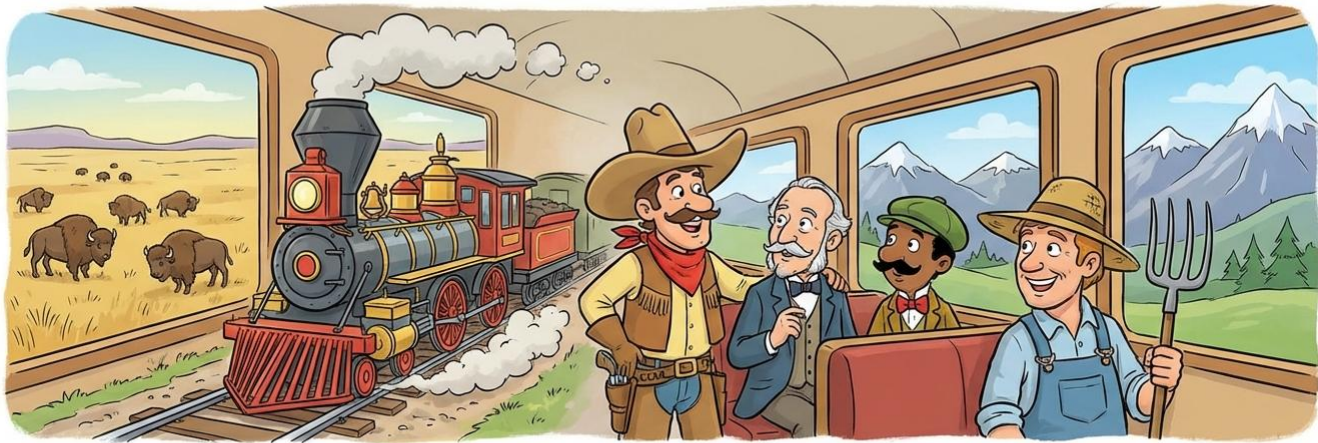

Chapter 19: A Broken Bridge



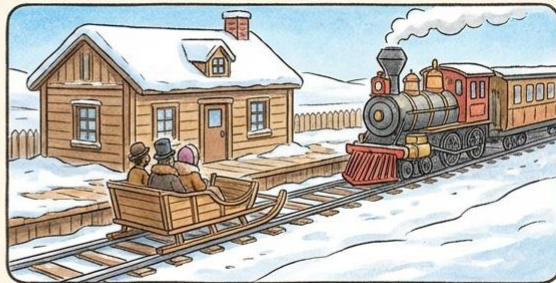
A bridge was broken.

Chapter 23: Back in England

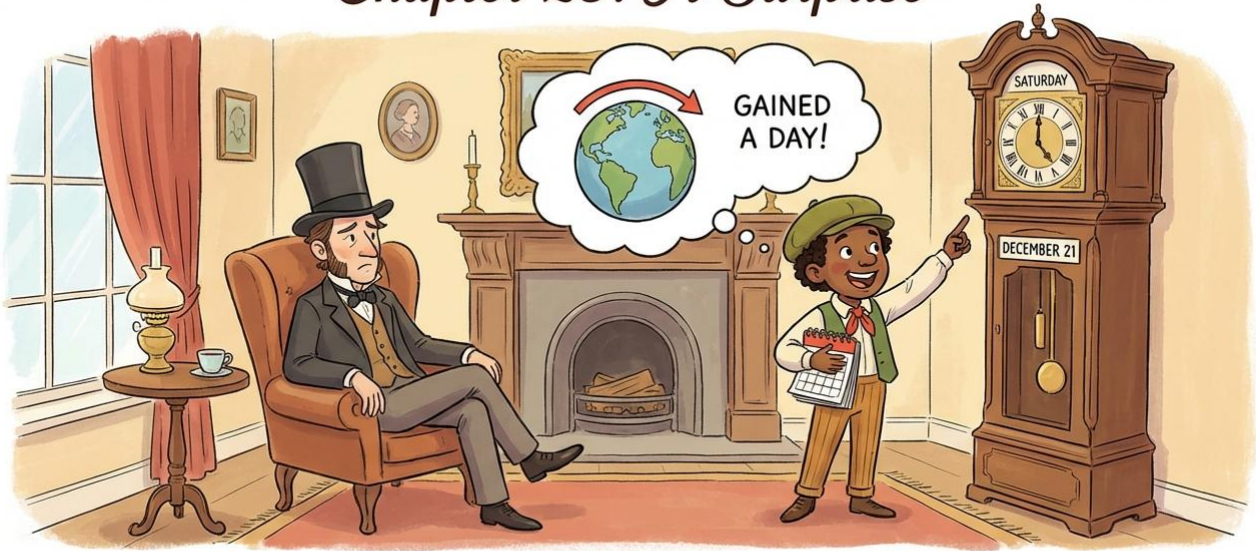
