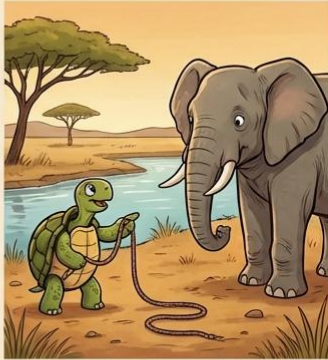


Who Is Stronger?

Hippo was very strong and proud.



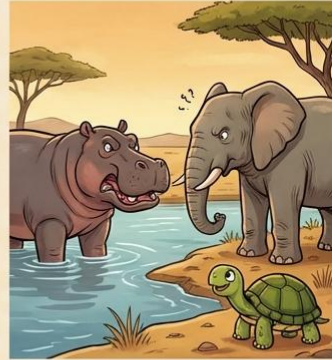
Chapter 2: Turtle's Plan

Chapter 4: Light at Last!

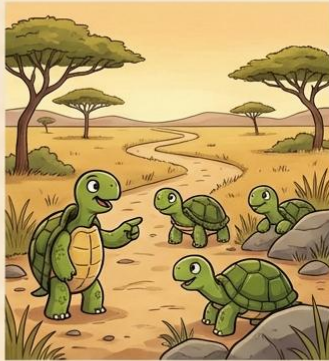
He brought light to his home and all the animals were happy.

The Long Race



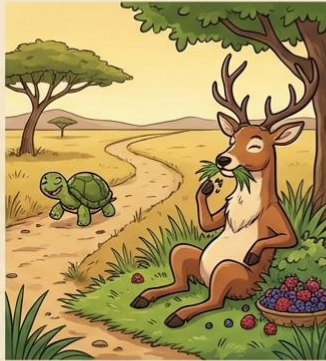
Chapter 1: The Challenge.

Chapter 3: Spider's Loss

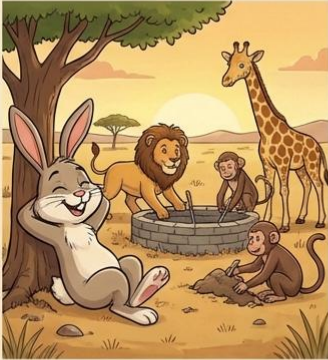
Spider lost his wife and children.

Animals dug a well but Rabbit did not help, so they said he could not drink the water.



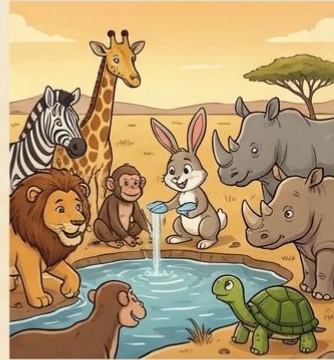
Chapter 2: The Honey Trick

Spider and Bird traveled together.



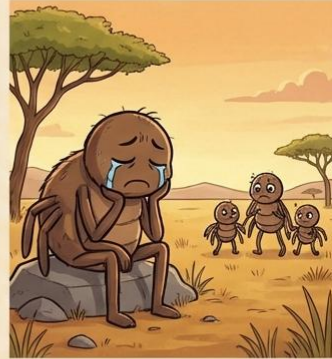
Chapter 2: The Greedy Meal

Turtle and Spider traveled. Spider was greedy with food.



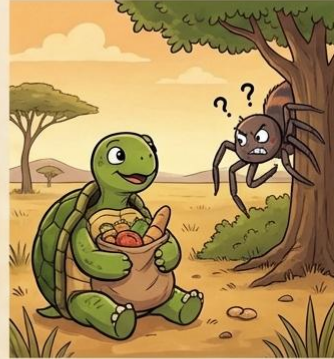
Chapter 2: Turtle's Trick.

Chapter 3: Getting Back.

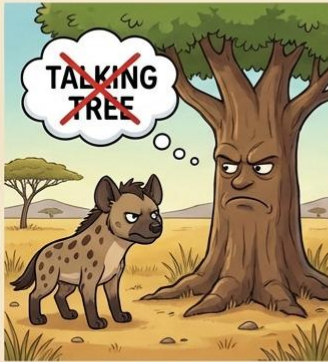
He got back all his things that Spider took.

Dog and Jackal were brothers. They were cold and hungry.



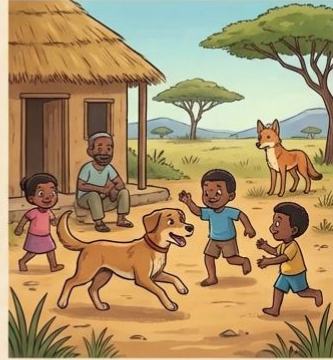
Chapter 2: Dog Goes to the Village

Turtle and Snake were friends and shared food.



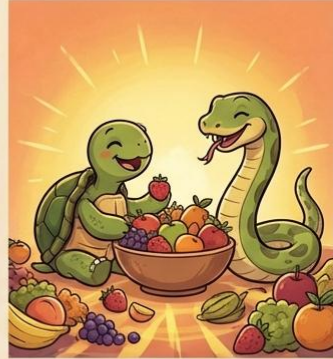
Chapter 2: Greedy Snake.

Chapter 4: Goodness Wins

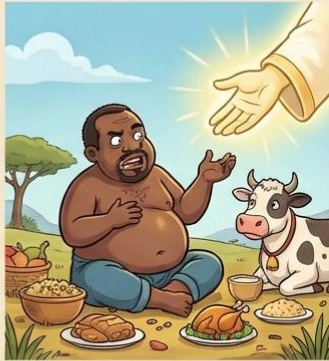
...and a happy life.

Imana and the Greedy Man



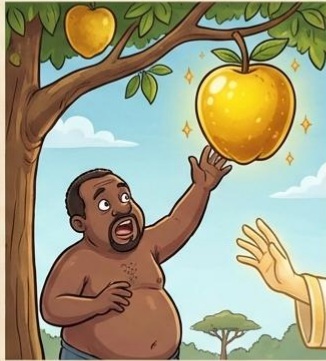
Chapter 1: Lazy Seguku

The Legend of Banga



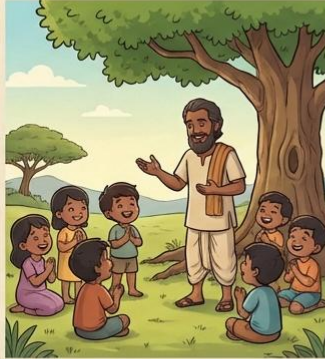
Chapter 1: Banga Falls
