

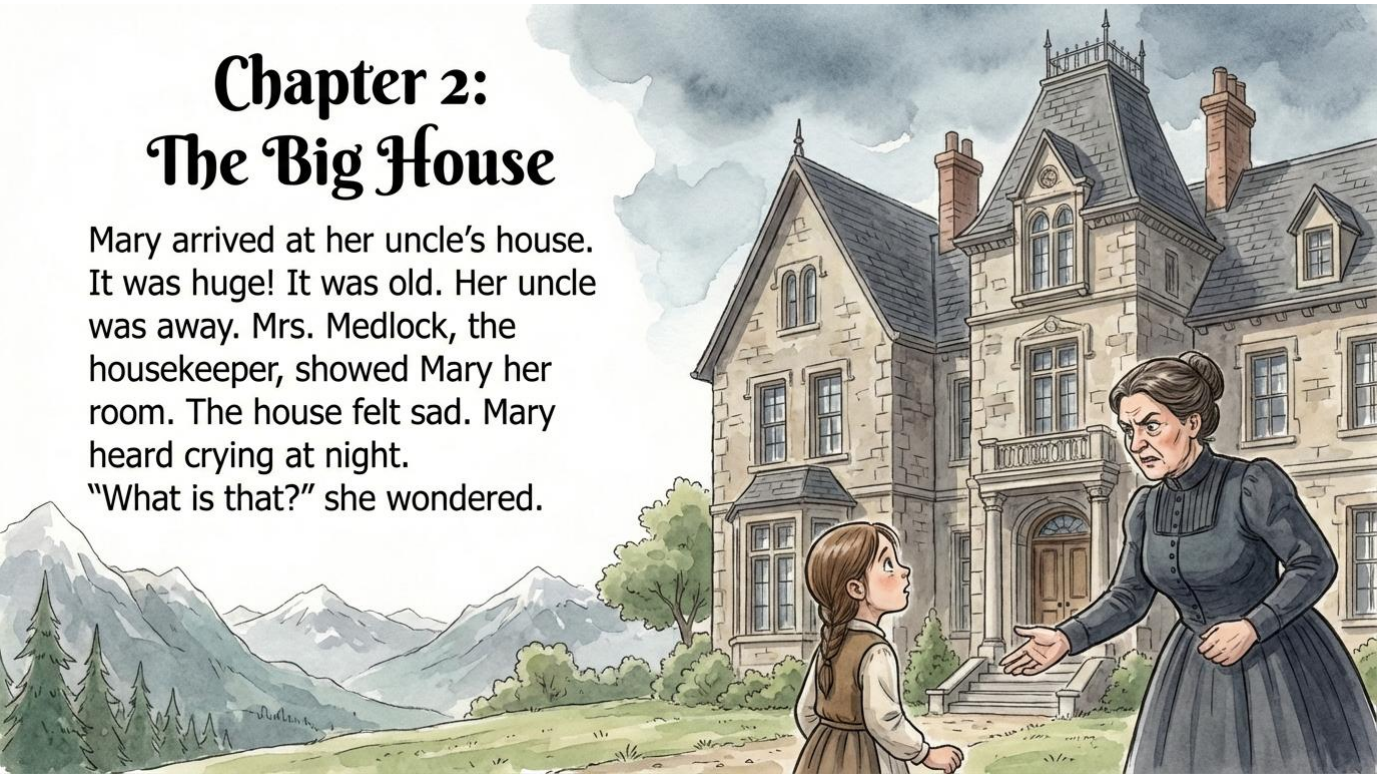
Chapter 1: Mary is Alone

Finding the Key

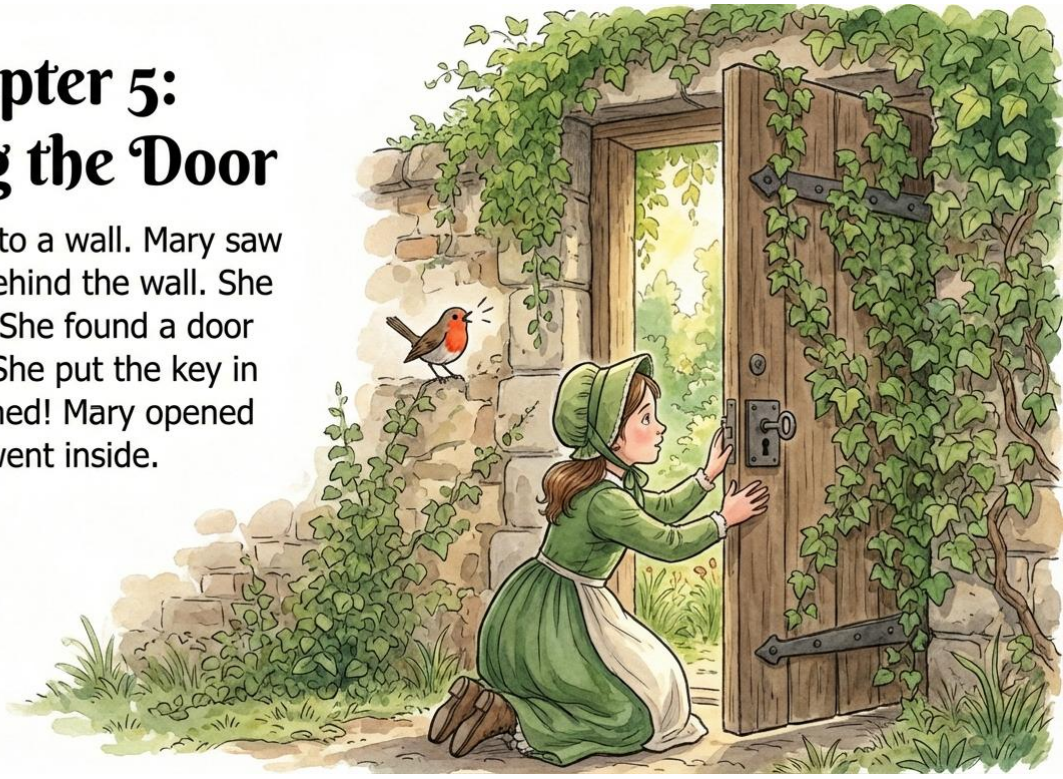

Chapter 6:

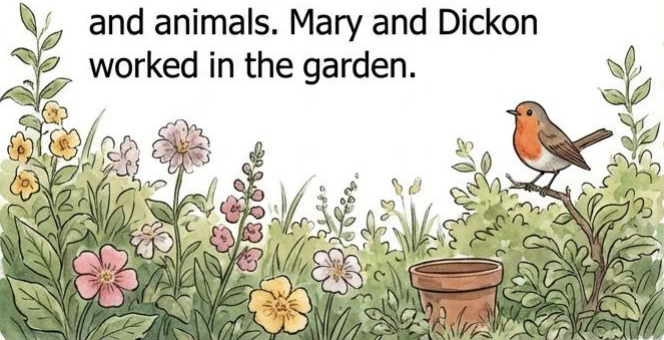
Inside the Secret Garden

Chapter 7: Meeting Dickon

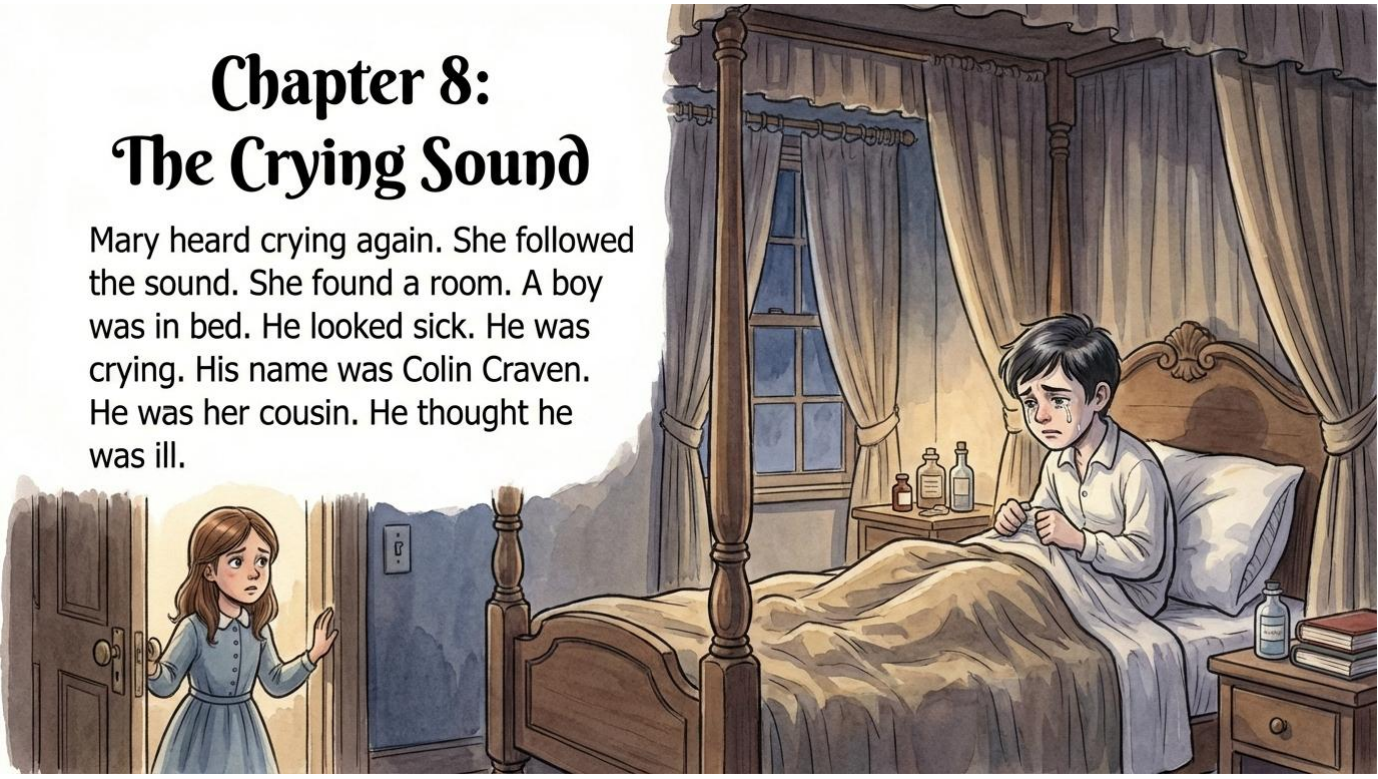

Chapter 8:

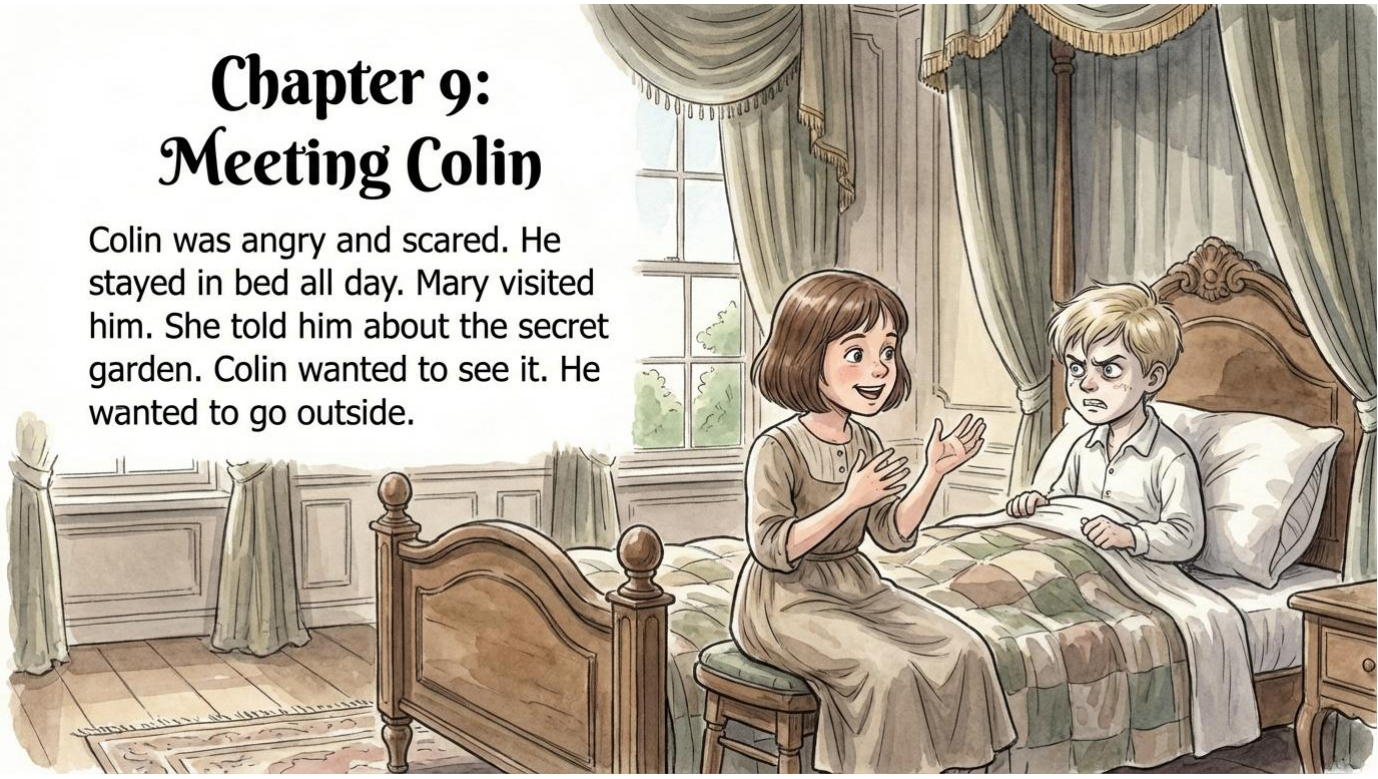
The Crying Sound

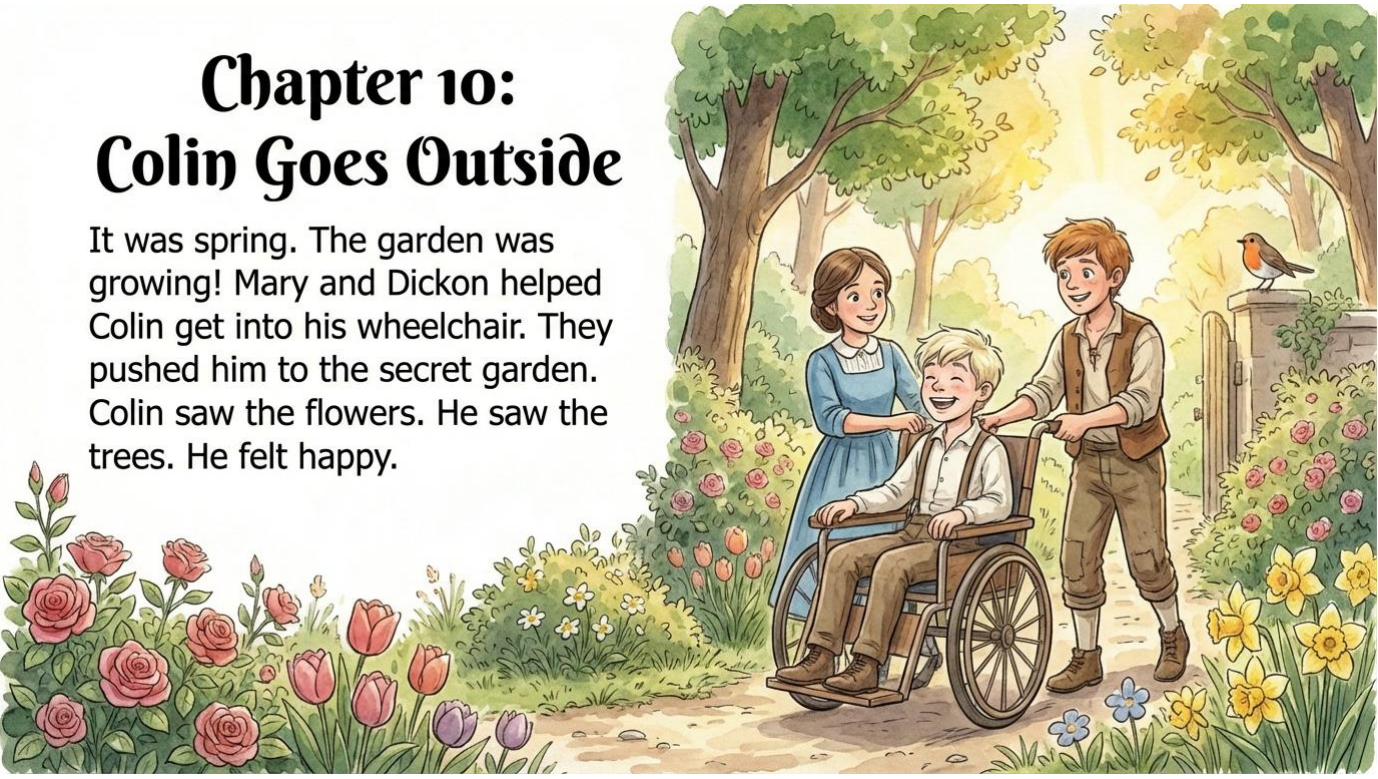
Chapter 9: Meeting Colin

Colin was angry and scared. He stayed in bed all day. Mary visited him. She told him about the secret garden. Colin wanted to see it. He wanted to go outside.



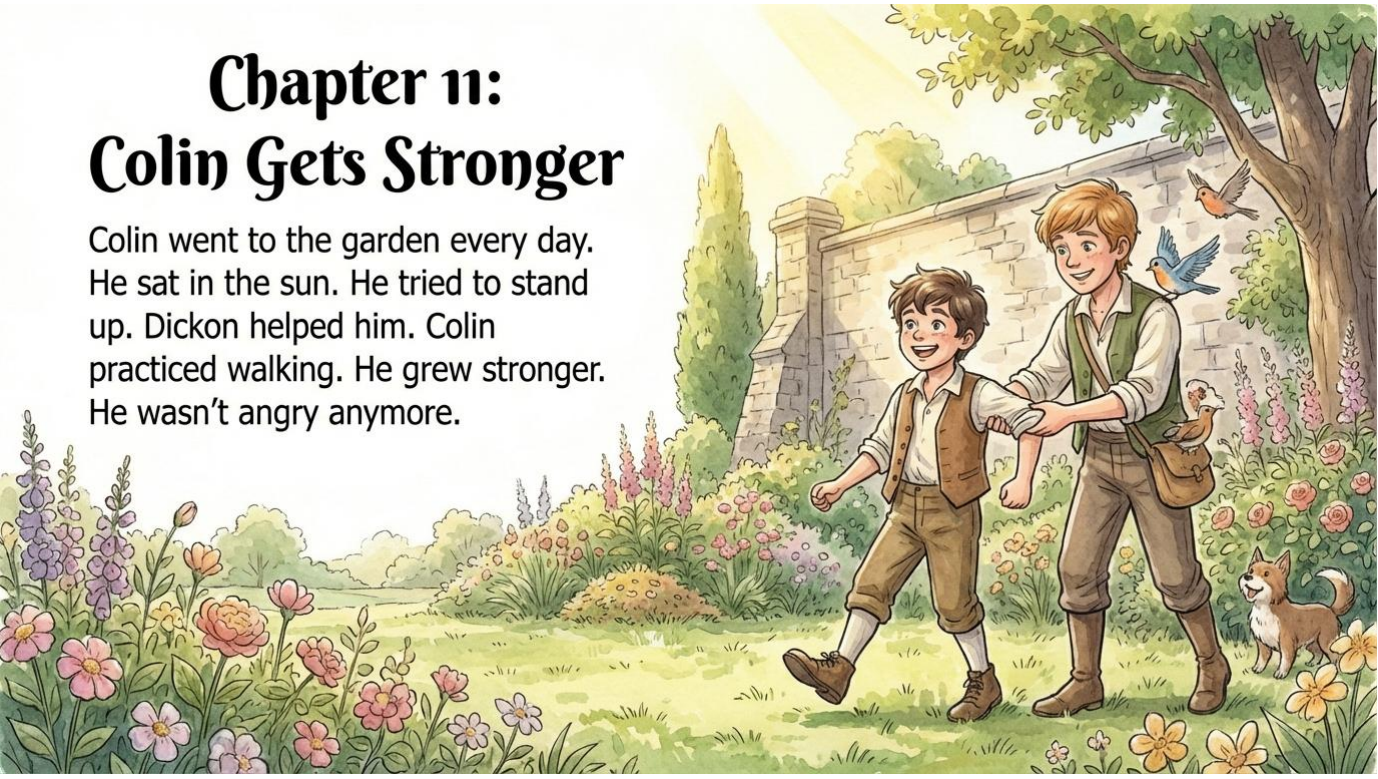
Chapter 10: Colin Goes Outside
